6. That Defendant has not previously been convicted of any misdemeanor or felony;



Now comes **Sergeant Jerome Patrick**, hereafter referred to as your affiant and states and deposes as follows:

1.) Your affiant is a police officer for the City of Moline currently assigned to the criminal investigation division of the Moline Police Department.

2.) Your affiant is currently investigating the case of People v. William Beck 99 CF 917 where the defendant is charged with Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse and Attempt Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse.

3.) Your affiant during the course of his investigation has interviewed a number of individuals who have indicated that defendant Beck would allow the minors in his residence located at 4605 31st Avenue, Moline, Rock Island County, Illinois.

4.) Your affiant was informed that while at the residence the defendant and the minors would be engaged in a number of activities including "playing" on his computer and logging onto the Internet.

5.) Your affiant was informed that the minors had access to defendant Beck's residence even while the defendant was not present.

6.) Your affiant, was informed by the minors interviewed that they were attracted to the defendant's residence because of the different activities (swimming pool) (pool table) (alcohol) (computer) that they would be allowed to do there.

7.) Your affiant was informed that the defendant and the minors, while on the computer, observed sexually explicit photographs downloaded from the Internet.

8.) Your affiant, along with fellow officers, executed a valid search warrant on the defendant's residence and did in fact locate the computer

believed to be the one on which the minors observed the sexually explicit photographs, as well as various computer accessories and various pornographic magazines.

9.) Your affiant knows that the computer is a Macintosh Performa575 with an apple design keyboard; apple color style writer 2400 printer; global village modem.

10.) Your affiant is responsible for investigating violations of state laws, including violations of laws regarding the knowing receipt or possession of prohibited and/or restricted merchandise, including child pornography and material related to the sexual exploitation of children by any means including by computer of any visual depiction if such visual depiction involves the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct.

11.)  - 4.) private identification codes or numbers which permit access to a computer by authorized computer users or generate billings to consumers for purchase of goods and services, including by not limited to credit card transactions and telecommunications services or permit electronic fund transfers;
 - 5.) software or programs in either machine or human readable form;
 - 6.) any other tangible or intangible item relating to a computer or any part thereof.

25.) Pursuant to my training and experience, I have learned that:

- a.) Child pornography is not readily available in retail establishments; accordingly, individuals who wish to obtain child pornography do so by ordering it from abroad or by discreet contact with other individuals who have it available.
- b.) The use of computers to traffic in, trade, or collect child pornography and obscenity has become one of the preferred methods of obtaining obscene and child pornographic materials. An individual familiar with a computer can use it, usually in the privacy of his own home or office, to interact with another individual or a business offering such materials in this country or elsewhere in the world. The use of a computer provides individuals interested in obscenity or child pornography with a sense of privacy and secrecy not attainable by other media. It also permits the individuals to contact and interact with many more individuals than through the use of the mails.

2 versus William C Beck. Mr. Beck is in court in person with
3 his attorney, Walter Braud. State is present by Assistant
4 State's Attorney Jessie Guzman.

5 I called this case up for status this morning
6 based on the fact that the State and defense have told me
7 they were close to some type of plea agreement in this
8 case. Is that correct, Miss Guzman?

9 MS. GUZMAN: Yes, it is, Your Honor.

10 THE COURT: What is the agreement, the plea agreement,
11 if any?

12 MS. GUZMAN: Your Honor, the defendant will be pleading
13 guilty to 3 counts. That will be Count 1, Count 2, and
14 Count 6, and the State will be moving to dismiss Counts 3,
15 4 and 5.

16 THE COURT: Is this an open plea?

17 MS. GUZMAN: Yes, it is.

18 MR. BRAUD: Yes.

19 MS. GUZMAN: With a cap of 6 years.

20 THE COURT: There is an agreement of cap of 6 years,
21 anywhere from probation to cap of 6 years?

22 MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

23 THE COURT: So then the defendant is pleading guilty
24 to Count 1, aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Class 2.

IMAGED

1 Count 1 is a Class 2 felony. Count 2 is attempt aggravated
2 criminal sexual abuse, a Class 3 felony, and Count 6 is
3 aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony. When
4 you say there's a cap of 6 years are the sentences to run
5 concurrent? Is that the spirit of this agreement?

6 MR. BRAUD: Yes, Your Honor.

7 MS. GUZMAN: Yes, it is.

8 THE COURT: Is that your understanding of the
9 agreement, Mr. Braud?

10 MR. BRAUD: Yes.

11 THE COURT: Is that your understanding Mr. Beck?

12 DEFENDANT: Yes.

13 THE COURT: We'll have a full sentencing hearing at a
14 later date. Is that correct?

15 MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

16 MR. BRAUD: Yes.

17 THE COURT: Is there any prior record on the
18 defendant, Mr. Braud?

19 MR. BRAUD: No, Your Honor.

20 THE COURT: This is his first time in criminal
21 activity with the courts?

22 MR. BRAUD: It is, Your Honor.

23 THE COURT: The court will concur with the agreement,
24 the limited agreement of the State. Mr. Braud, have you

1 advised your client of his rights under the law and the
2 consequences of entering pleas of guilty?

3 MR. BRAUD: I have, Your Honor.

4 THE COURT: Mr. Beck, your lawyer tells me now you
5 wish to plead guilty to Count 1, aggravated criminal sexual
6 abuse, a Class 2 felony; Count 2, attempted aggravated
7 criminal sexual abuse, a Class 3 felony, and lastly Count
8 6, aggravated--. Count two is a Class 3 felony. Count 6
9 is aggravated criminal sexual abuse, also a Class 2
10 felony. Is that correct?

11 DEFENDANT: Yes it is.

12 THE COURT: Has your lawyer told you about your rights
13 under the law and consequences of entering pleas of
14 guilty?

15 DEFENDANT: Yes, he has.

16 THE COURT: What is your plea to Count 1, aggravated
17 criminal sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony, guilty or not
18 guilty?

19 MR. BRAUD: We need to identify which victim is
20 involved.

21 THE COURT: This would be JDP, date of birth October
22 13th, 1982.

23 DEFENDANT: Guilty, Your Honor.

24 THE COURT: Count 2, attempted aggravated sexual

1 abuse. This would be BNJ, a Class 3 felony, guilty or not
2 guilty?

3 DEFENDANT: Guilty, Your Honor.

4 THE COURT: And lastly, Count 6, aggravated criminal
5 sexual abuse, the alleged victim is AJT.

6 DEFENDANT: Guilty, Your Honor.

7 THE COURT: Okay. Before I accept your pleas of
8 guilty, Mr. Beck, I want to be sure you understand your
9 legal rights and the rights you give up when you plead
10 guilty. If you do not understand anything I say please
11 stop me, ask any questions you have or talk to your lawyer,
12 Mr. Braud, and have him ask me questions on your behalf.
13 Will you do that?

14 DEFENDANT: Yes.

15 THE COURT: I will take Counts 1 and 6 together.
16 Those are the Class 2's. Then I will go back to Count 2
17 which is a Class 3. Okay now I will read you the charge in
18 Count 1, Mr. Beck, and Count 6.

19 Count 1 states on the 21st day of August, 1999
20 within the County of Rock Island, State of Illinois,
21 William C Beck committed the offense of aggravated criminal
22 sexual abuse in that you knowingly committed an act of
23 sexual conduct with JDP, whose date of birth is October
24 13th, 1982, who was at least 13 years of age but under 17

1 years of age in that you fondled the genitals of JDP for
2 the purpose of sexual gratification of yourself or the
3 victim and the defendant was at least five years older than
4 JDP. That's a Class 2 felony. Do you understand the
5 nature of that charge, Mr. Beck?

6 DEFENDANT: Yes.

7 THE COURT: Is that the charge you wish to plead
8 guilty to?

9 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

10 THE COURT: Count 6, which is also a Class 2 felony,
11 states that during the summer of the year 1997 within the
12 County of Rock Island, State of Illinois, William C Beck
13 committed the offense of aggravated criminal sexual abuse
14 in that you knowingly committed an act of sexual conduct
15 with AJT, whose date of birth is July 8, 1983, who was at
16 least 13 years of age but under 17 years of age, in that
17 you touched genitals of AJT for the purposes of sexual
18 gratification of yourself and that the defendant was at
19 least five years older than AJT. That's also a Class 2
20 felony. Do you understand the nature of that charge,
21 Mr. Beck?

22 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

23 THE COURT: Is that the charge you wish to plead guilty
24 to?

1 MR. BRAUD: I think there's an error in the date of the
2 alleged occurrence. I think it says 1997. I think it's
3 1998.

4 THE COURT: Okay.

5 MS. GUZMAN: That may be.

6 THE COURT: Do you wish to amend? I don't file the
7 charges. I only read them.

8 MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

9 THE COURT: You are moving to amend?

10 MS. GUZMAN: Yes, Your Honor.

11 THE COURT: It would be 1998. No objection?

12 MR. BRAUD: No objection.

13 THE COURT: You are the one that brought it to the
14 attention of the court?

15 MR. BRAUD: Yes.

16 THE COURT: Now Mr. Beck, as indicated you entered a
17 plea of guilty to Counts 1 and 6, both Class 2 felonies.
18 If you are convicted of Class 2 felonies you could be
19 sentenced anywhere from 3 to 7 years in the Illinois
20 Department of Corrections followed by a two year mandatory
21 supervised release period. Do you understand that?

22 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

23 THE COURT: You can also be placed on a term of
24 probation for up to four years with the condition you could

IMAGED

1 be ordered to serve the first 6 months in the county jail
2 or up to four years of periodic imprisonment and could be
3 fined up to 10 thousand dollars. Now do you understand the
4 possible penalties on Counts 1 and 6?

5 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

6 THE COURT: Knowing the possible penalties do you wish
7 to enter pleas of guilty to Count 1 and 6 based on the plea
8 agreement?

9 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

10 THE COURT: Count 2 states that on the 29th day of
11 October, 1999 within the County of Rock Island, State of
12 Illinois, William C Beck committed the offense of attempt
13 aggravated criminal sexual abuse in that the said
14 defendant, with the intent to commit the offense of
15 aggravated criminal sexual abuse, in violation of Section
16 12- 16 (f) of Act 5 of Chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled
17 Statutes, performed a substantial step towards the
18 commission of that offense in that you, who were 17 years
19 of age or older, and held, as a high school golf coach of
20 BNJ, whose date of birth is September 14, 1982, a position
21 of trust in relation to BNJ committed an act of sexual
22 conduct with BNJ who was at least 13 years of age but under
23 18 years of age when the act was committed in that you
24 attempted to fondle the genitals of BNJ for the purposes of

1 sexual gratification of yourself or for the victim.

2 That's a Class 3 felony. Do you understand the
3 nature of that charge, Mr. Beck?

4 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

5 THE COURT: Is that the charge you wish to plead
6 guilty to?

7 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

8 THE COURT: Now Mr. Beck, the law provides for certain
9 penalties if you're convicted of this offense. A Class 3
10 felony you could be sentenced on this offense anywhere from
11 two to five years in the Illinois Department of
12 Corrections, followed by a one year mandatory supervised
13 release period. Do you understand that?

14 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

15 THE COURT: You could also be placed on a term of
16 probation or conditional discharge for up to four years or
17 no, up to 30 months with the condition you could be ordered
18 to serve the first 6 months in the county jail or up to 18
19 months of periodic imprisonment and could be fined up to 10
20 thousand dollars. Now do you understand the possible
21 penalties on Count 2?

22 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

23 THE COURT: Knowing the possible penalties on Count 2,
24 do you wish to enter a plea of guilty to that charge

1 pursuant to the plea agreement that you made with the
2 State?

3 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

4 THE COURT: Now Mr. Beck, do you understand you have a
5 right to plead not guilty and require the State to prove
6 these charges against you beyond a reasonable doubt? Do
7 you understand that?

8 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

9 THE COURT: Do you understand, Mr. Beck, when you
10 plead guilty you give up your right to a trial of any
11 kind? That is, if you plead guilty there will be no trial
12 either by a jury or by this court? Do you understand
13 that?

14 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

15 THE COURT: If you did have a trial, Mr. Beck, you
16 would have the right to see the State's witnesses as they
17 testified against you and your lawyer would have a right to
18 ask them questions. You also would have a right to present
19 witnesses in your own behalf and you would have a right to
20 obtain subpoenas from this court to make sure that your
21 witnesses appeared in court to testify. You would further
22 have the right to testify in your own behalf at trial or
23 you would have the right to remain silent. That is, to say
24 nothing. If you did decide to remain silent evidence of

1 that silence could not be used against you in any way. Do
2 you understand, Mr. Beck, that when you plead guilty you
3 give up all these rights I have just discussed?

4 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

5 THE COURT: When you plead guilty, Mr. Beck, you also
6 give up the right to have a jury trial. Now a jury would
7 be made up of twelve people chosen in part by you and your
8 lawyer. The jury would hear all the statements and
9 arguments by the lawyers, all the evidence in this case,
10 then the jury would receive my instructions on the law.
11 Then the jury would decide whether or not the State had
12 proved you guilty beyond a reasonable doubt of these
13 charges. Now do you understand what a jury is and what it
14 does, Mr. Beck?

15 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

16 THE COURT: Do you wish to give up your right to a jury
17 trial and plead guilty to these 3 charges?

18 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

19 THE COURT: Do you have a written waiver, Mr. Braud?
20 I have before me here in 99 CF 917 a waiver of jury trial
21 and plea of guilty to Count 1, aggravated criminal sexual
22 abuse, a Class 2 felony; Count 2, attempted aggravated
23 criminal sexual abuse, a Class 3 felony; and lastly Count
24 6, aggravated criminal sexual abuse, also a Class 2 felony

IMAGED

1 signed William C Beck. Is that your signature, Mr. Beck?

2 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

3 THE COURT: Now Mr. Beck, do you understand when you
4 sign these forms, this form you are saying to this court
5 that you want to give up your right to a jury trial and you
6 are pleading guilty to the charges of aggravated criminal
7 sexual abuse, Count 1, a Class 2 felony; attempted
8 aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Count 2, a Class 3
9 felony, aggravated criminal sexual abuse, Count 6, a Class
10 2 felony? Do you understand that?

11 DEFENDANT: Yes.

12 THE COURT: Has any threat of any kind been made to
13 get you to plead to these charges, Mr. Beck?

14 DEFENDANT: No.

15 THE COURT: Has anyone forced you to plead guilty to
16 these charges?

17 DEFENDANT: No.

18 THE COURT: Are you pleading guilty of your own free
19 will?

20 DEFENDANT: Yes, I am.

21 THE COURT: Now has anyone made any promises to you
22 about what I would or would not do if you plead guilty to
23 these charges outside the plea agreement?

24 DEFENDANT: No.

1 THE COURT: Before accepting the pleas, Miss Guzman,
2 would you give the court factual basis on each count?

3 MS. GUZMAN: I will, Your Honor. As to Count 1,
4 sometime within the month of August approximately 21st of
5 1999, the minor, initials JDP, date of birth 10/13/82, was
6 at the defendant's residence. The defendant made a habit
7 of having younger juveniles at his home where they were
8 allowed to drink alcohol and smoke and play video games and
9 do things at his house.

10 THE COURT: This was going on at this time?

11 MS. GUZMAN: Yes, it was. It was ongoing. To what the
12 kids would do would be frequent his house, and evidently
13 the policy was that if you drank you had to stay at the
14 residence overnight.

15 At some period of time this particular minor
16 spent the night at the defendant's residence and evidently
17 he was sleeping on the couch in the living room. At
18 approximately 3:00 in the morning he was awakened by the
19 defendant when he felt the defendant's hands on his
20 genitals. The minor advised his pants were unzipped and
21 partially down. He was wearing a T shirt, underwear at the
22 time, and he advised that the defendant was rubbing his
23 hand on his penis. He advised that this lasted about 20
24 seconds. The juvenile asked the defendant what he was

1 doing. At that time the defendant then seized doing that,
2 told the minor that this would never happen again, and also
3 asked the minor not to tell anyone. He got up and went to
4 the basement where there were other people sleeping. At
5 that time then the defendant would have been, his birth
6 date was in '58. This occurred in 1999, so he would have
7 been approximately 41 years old and--.

8 THE COURT: Minor would have been?

9 MS. GUZMAN: The minor would have been at the time 16
10 years old.

11 THE COURT: He was at least 13 but under 17 years of
12 age.

13 MS. GUZMAN: Correct. As to Count 2, this is again
14 another minor with the initials BNJ, date of birth is
15 9/14/82. BNJ is a member or was a member of the Moline
16 High School golf team where the defendant was a coach. In
17 approximately October of 1999 the minor had spent the night
18 at the defendant's residence. Again I believe there was
19 alcohol involved in that instance as well.

20 The minor stated that the defendant as he was
21 asleep he awoke, he was awakened when he felt a hand on his
22 lower stomach and upper crotch area. The juvenile advised
23 that it was the defendant and his hand was down his pants,
24 and when he woke up he realized that his pants were

1 unbuttoned and unzipped, and he said it was dark but he was
2 aware it was the defendant because he recognized his voice
3 because the defendant said to him just relax, let me do
4 it. The minor advised that he hit the defendant's hand
5 away and told him to get off of him. He then the minor
6 fell back asleep, woke up later and left the residence.

7 THE COURT: This occurred at night? Is this when this
8 occurred?

9 MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

10 THE COURT: And the minor was at the residence of the
11 defendant?

12 MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

13 THE COURT: Was this a part of the ongoing party?

14 MS. GUZMAN: What happened in this one case this minor,
15 I believe his parents were out of town and he did not, he
16 was not allowed to stay at a friend's house, so what the
17 parents wanted him to do was to stay with somebody they
18 could trust and who they entrusted with this child's safety
19 and they knew he would look out for him. He stayed. I
20 believe the parents spoke to the defendant and then
21 inquired as to if that was something that they could do and
22 he agreed and. . .

23 THE COURT: He was the golf coach?

24 MS. GUZMAN: Exactly.

1 MR. BRAUD: I'm not sure if he was a golf coach at that
2 time. He at some point was the golf coach.

3 MS. GUZMAN: That was why he was there actually, but
4 the minor did inform us that he had been out drinking and
5 that this was a place that he could stay when that
6 happened. He did not actually make it to his genitals, but
7 he was attempting to fondle his genitals for the purpose of
8 sexual gratification of the defendant. At that time the
9 minor would have been 16 years old.

10 THE COURT: He would have been 17 according to the
11 date of birth, 9/14/82. The date is 29 of October, 1999.

12 MS. GUZMAN: I'm sorry. That's correct. As to Count
13 6, within the summer of 1998 the minor, whose initials are
14 AJT, date of birth 7/8 of 83. During the course of the
15 investigation we interviewed a lot of children. This minor
16 came forward and informed the investigators that he first
17 met the defendant as his Sixth grade teacher. That he
18 began going over to the defendant's residence as part of
19 the whole hang out place where they would swim in the pool,
20 watch TV.

21 The minor indicated that he had spent the night
22 at the defendant's residence. Again, that he said they
23 would be drinking alcohol and that was the rule they had to
24 stay there at the residence. The minor indicated that he

1 was in the kitchen getting pop, that the defendant began
2 rubbing his shoulders and from behind tried putting his
3 hands on his belly at the belt towards his waistline and he
4 stopped him only after the defendant was rubbing and
5 stroking the outside of the minor's pants and his crotch
6 area outside of his clothes. At that time the
7 defendant. . .

8 THE COURT: Well did he touch the genitals?

9 MS. GUZMAN: He was rubbing the genitals outside the
10 clothing and as he was rubbing his genitals on top of the
11 clothing the defendant asked him do you like this? The
12 minor at that time said no. The defendant stopped and then
13 the minor went downstairs immediately afterwards.

14 THE COURT: Okay. The age difference was?

15 MS. GUZMAN: At that time the minor would have been 15
16 years old and the defendant would have been 40 years old at
17 the time.

18 THE COURT: Okay. That's the minors testimony would
19 be that he touched his genitals, even though it was on the
20 outside of his pants, he touched his genitals?

21 MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

22 THE COURT: That is an element of the offense, Miss
23 Guzman, they must touch the genitals.

24 MS. GUZMAN: Yes. He said he was rubbing on top of his

1 clothes on top of his genitals and when he asked him do you
2 like this? That was what the minor told us.

3 THE COURT: Okay. Mr. Braud---, Now did the parents
4 know this drinking was going on? Was this hidden to the
5 parents?

6 MS. GUZMAN: It was. From the conversations that we've
7 had from the parents and the defendant is, was a teacher
8 himself. They all were very much blinded by the defendant
9 and his demeanor. Everybody thought he was a nice guy and
10 he was a teacher. They were not aware that-- They thought
11 the kids were going over there to hang out. He had a
12 swimming pool. He had a pool table, that they were hanging
13 out over there, and it was a safe place to be as opposed to
14 being on the street.

15 It turns out he was buying the kids alcohol and
16 providing a place for them to drink. He would-- a couple
17 of the kids had access to his house without him being
18 there, and there have been occasions when there were kids
19 there without his being there, and so I mean they knew
20 insofar as they knew they were hanging out there.

21 THE COURT: Okay, Mr. Braud, do you agree with the
22 statement of the facts as substantially correct what the
23 State would present in a hearing at trial?

24 MR. BRAUD: With respect to the touching I think it's

1 all substantially correct. With regard to the
2 circumstances surrounding the touchings, many of those
3 would be disputed.

4 THE COURT: You think there's sufficient evidence here
5 to prove the elements of the crime?

6 MR. BRAUD: Of the touchings yes, of the elements of
7 the crime.

8 THE COURT: And the age difference?

9 MR. BRAUD: Yes.

10 THE COURT: Okay, Mr. Beck, knowing the nature of the
11 charges against you, the possible penalties and knowing
12 your rights under the law, do you still wish to plead
13 guilty to Count 1, the offense of aggravated criminal
14 sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony; Count 2, attempted
15 aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 3 felony, Count
16 6, aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony?

17 DEFENDANT: Yes, Your Honor.

18 THE COURT: Let the record reflect that the court
19 finds the defendant understands the nature of the charges
20 against him, the possible penalties and his legal rights.
21 I find that the defendant is pleading guilty knowingly and
22 voluntarily, and I further find there is a factual basis
23 for the guilty pleas. I therefore accept the defendant's
24 pleas of guilty to the charges Count 1, aggravated criminal

1 sexual abuse, a Class 2 felony; Count 2, attempted
2 aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 3 felony; lastly
3 Count 6, aggravated criminal sexual abuse, a Class 2
4 felony, and I enter judgment on those pleas of guilty.

5 Now the court will order a presentence
6 investigation on this matter. Mr. Braud, do you want a
7 Tasc evaluation or not?

8 MR. BRAUD: It won't be necessary, no.

9 THE COURT: This matter is set for sentencing at 1:30
10 P.M. on the 18th day of May, 2,000. We will see everybody
11 back here then. All the conditions of bond remain in full
12 force and effect as imposed by the court at the last
13 hearing we had. Here is copies of the orders for
14 everyone. We will see you back here then.

15 (Which was all of the evidence offered and
16 received and all other proceedings had in the
17 trial of the above-entitled cause.)

ORDER THAT DEFENDANT BE TESTED FOR PRESENCE
OF ANY SEXUALLY TRANSMISSIBLE DISEASE

Defendant having been convicted of the offenses of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse (Count I & VI) and Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse (Count II) in violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-16(d) (I & VI) and 720 ILCS 5/8-4(a) (II), pursuant to the provisions of 730 ILCS 5/5-5-3(g) is hereby ORDERED to present himself to Dr. Larry Peterson at the Rock Island County Correctional Center, located at 1317 - 3rd Avenue, Rock Island, Illinois, within ten (10) days of entry of this order and at that time and location submit to medical testing to determine whether the defendant has any sexually transmissible disease including infection with hum immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or any other identified causative agent of acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS).

The medical testing shall be performed only by an appropriately licensed medical practitioner(s) and may include an analysis of any of the defendant's bodily fluid as well as an examination of the defendant's person. Except as otherwise provided herein, the results of this test shall be kept strictly confidential by all medical personnel involved in the testing of the defendant.

An authorized person from the Rock Island County Health Department shall communicate the test results directly to the undersigned in writing and deliver same in a sealed envelope to the undersigned for in camera inspection.

The Court designates the Rock Island County Health Department, Director and designated employees thereof as liaison with and to act on

behalf of this court to do any/all of the following:

1. Shall notify the defendant of the test results by the most practical and efficient means.

2. Shall, upon confirmation of written request notify all persons who have been identified as a "victim" that a test has been performed upon the defendant and that the victim may obtain the results of that test in person at an appointed time or otherwise if requested from a staff member of the Rock Island County Health Department. Any victim under age 15 at time of commission of offense shall also have a parent or legal guardian notified and that parent or legal guardian shall accompany the victim during the revelation of defendant's test results to the victim(s).

3. The Rock Island County Health Department shall provide information on the availability of HIV testing and counseling at Department of Public Health Facilities to all parties and shall, where deemed appropriate, provide such counseling to any party to whom test results are revealed.

4. In the event that any person designated as a "victim" resides outside of the area where personal contact by Rock Island County Health Department to reveal test results cannot be accomplished, then Rock Island County Health Department, maintaining the same degree of medical confidentiality as previously described herein shall designate a Public Health Department or facility and designated employee/representative therein to notify in person, if practical the victim revealing the defendant's test result to victim within the County/State wherein the victim resides. ONLY AS A LAST RESORT SHALL THE DEFENDANT'S TEST RESULTS BE MAILED TO A VICTIM. This method of notification should be specifically requested by the victim before it is to be utilized.

5. The Rock Island County State's Attorneys Office shall immediately contact the Rock Island County Health Department and provide the department with information relative to:

a. case number

IMAGED

b. identify and location of defendant

c. identity of any and all victims including current address and age of victim, names and addresses for parents or guardian of minor victim

d. other information helpful to discharge of Health Department's responsibilities herein

6. Upon completion of all duties and responsibilities herein, the Director of the Rock Island County Health Department or a designated person shall execute a certificate of compliance whereby, under oath, the person so signing swears or affirms that the Rock Island County Health Department and representatives thereof have complied with this order, listing any failures thereto and reason for non compliance.

The costs of this testing procedure shall be added to the court cost schedule filed in this case and taxed as costs against this defendant. The Rock Island County Health Department shall upon request by the Office of the Circuit Clerk, provide a statement as to the cost of defendant's testing.

WHEREFORE IT IS SO ORDERED.

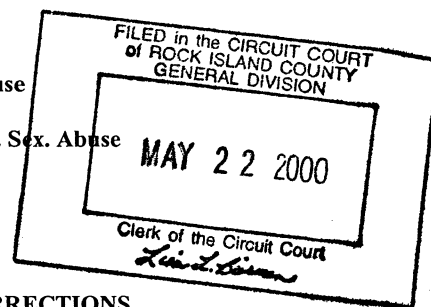

JUDGMENT - SENTENCE TO ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

WHEREAS the above-named defendant William C. Beck, DOB:5-27-58 as been adjudged guilty of the offenses enumerated below,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the defendant be and hereby is sentenced to confinement in the Illinois Department of Corrections for the term of years and months specified for each offense.

The Court finds that the defendant is entitled to receive credit for time actually served in custody of Rock Island County Sheriff's Department from November 8, 1999 through November 10, 1999 and from December 27, 1999 through December 30, 1999 and from May 23, 2000 to date of delivery to the Illinois Department of Corrections .

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant is ordered to pay the costs of prosecution herein. These fees, costs, and restitution (if applicable) are reduced to judgment against the defendant and are declared a lien upon the defendant's property. The defendant is ordered to see the payment hearing officer of Rock Island County within 28 DAYS of his release from the Department of Corrections to come up with a schedule for payment or schedule a court appearance to schedule payment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court deliver a copy of this order to the Sheriff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff take the defendant into custody and deliver him to the Department of Corrections which shall confine said defendant until expiration of his sentence or until he is otherwise released by operation of law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, 730 ILCS 5/5-5-3(g), the defendant shall undergo medical testing to determine whether the defendant has any sexually transmissible disease, including a test for H.I.V. and A.I.D.S. The testing shall be performed only by appropriately licensed medical practitioners and may include an analysis of any bodily fluids as well as an examination of the defendant's person. Except as otherwise provided by law, the results of such testing shall be kept strictly confidential by all medical personnel and personally delivered in a sealed envelop to the judge of the court in which the conviction was entered for the judge's inspection in camera. The judge, acting in the best interests of the victim and the public, shall have discretion to determine to whom, if anyone, the results of the testing may be revealed. The cost of the testing shall be paid by the defendant and assessed as a cost of the proceeding, to be paid out of bond posted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall register as a sex offender pursuant to 730 ILCS 150/3. He shall read and sign all registration forms required by the Illinois State Police.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant have specimens of his blood collected within forty-five (45) days at a place and time designated by the Illinois State Police for genetic marker analysis pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-4-3(b). The defendant shall pay an analysis fee of \$500.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Count I, II and VI are to run concurrently with one another.
