





AFFIDAVIT

Now comes **Sergeant Jerome Patrick**, hereafter referred to as your affiant and states and deposes as follows:

- 1.) Your affiant is a police officer for the City of Moline currently assigned to the criminal investigation division of the Moline Police Department.
- 2.) Your affiant is currently investigating the case of People v. William Beck 99 CF 917 where the defendant is charged with Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse and Attempt Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse.
- 3.) Your affiant during the course of his investigation has interviewed a number of individuals who have indicated that defendant Beck would allow the minors in his residence located at 4605 31st Avenue, Moline, Rock Island County, Illinois.
- 4.) Your affiant was informed that while at the residence the defendant and the minors would be engaged in a number of activities including "playing" on his computer and logging onto the Internet.
- 5.) Your affiant was informed that the minors had access to defendant Beck's residence even while the defendant was not present.
- 6.) Your affiant, was informed by the minors interviewed that they were attracted to the defendant's residence because of the different activities (swimming pool) (pool table) (alcohol) (computer) that they would be allowed to do there.
- 7.) Your affiant was informed that the defendant and the minors, while on the computer, observed sexually explicit photographs downloaded from the Internet.
- 8.) Your affiant, along with fellow officers, executed a valid search warrant on the defendant's residence and did in fact locate the computer

believed to be the one on which the minors observed the sexually explicit photographs, as well as various computer accessories and various pornographic magazines.

- 9.) Your affiant knows that the computer is a Macintosh Performa575 with an apple design keyboard; apple color style writer 2400 printer; global village modem.
- 10.) Your affiant is responsible for investigating violations of state laws, including violations of laws regarding the knowing receipt or possession of prohibited and/or restricted merchandise, including child pornography and material related to the sexual exploitation of children by any means including by computer of any visual depiction if such visual depiction involves the use of a minor engaging in sexually explicit conduct.
- Section 11-20.1 of Act 5 of Chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, makes it an offense for any person to film, videotape, photograph, or otherwise depict or portray by means of any similar visual medium or reproduction or depicts by computer any child whom he knows or reasonably should know to be under the age of 18 where such child is actually or by simulation engaged in any act of sexual contact involving the sex organs of the child and the mouth, anus, or sex organs of another person or animal, or which involves the mouth, anus or sex organs of the child and the sex organs of another person or animal; or where such child is actually or by simulation engaged in any act of masturbation; or actually or by simulation portrayed as being the object of, or otherwise engaged in, any act of lewd fondling, touching, or caressing involving an other person or animal; or where such child is actually or by simulation engaged in any act of excretion or urination within a sexual context or actually or by simulation portrayed or depicted as bound, fettered, or subject to sadistic, masochistic, or sadomasochistic abuse in any sexual context; or where such child is depicted or portrayed in any pose, posture or setting involving a lewd exhibition of the unclothed genitals, pubic area, buttocks, or, if such person is female,

a fully or partially do loped breast of the child other person. Section 11-20.1 of Act 5 of Chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes also makes it an offense that with the knowledge of the nature or content thereof to reproduce, disseminate, offer to disseminate, exhibit or possess with intent to disseminate any film, videotape, photograph or other similar visual reproduction or depiction by computer of any child whom the person knows or reasonably should know to be under the age of 18 engaged in any activity described above

- 12.) This investigation involves aggravated criminal sexual abuse of children, child pornography and its transmission and receipt through the use of the INTERNET.
- 13.) Section 11-20.1(f) of Act 5 of Chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled Statute defines, for the purpose of section 11-20.1, the following terms:
 - (a) "Disseminate" means (I) to sell, distribute, exchange or transfer possession, whether with or without consideration or (II) to make a depiction by computer available for distribution or downloading through the facilities of any telecommunications network or through any other means of transferring computer programs or data to a computer
 - (b) "Produce" means to direct, promote, advertise, publish,
 manufacture, issue, present or show
 - (c) "Reproduce" means to make a duplication or copy
 - (d) "Depict by computer" means to generate or create, or cause to be created or generated, a computer program or data that, after being processed by a computer either alone or in conjunction with one or more computer programs, results in a visual depiction on a computer monitor screen, or display.
 - (e) "Depiction by computer" means a computer program or data that,



after being ocessed by a computer eith alone or in conjunction with one or more computer programs, results in a visual depiction on a computer monitor, screen, or display.

- 14.) Section 16D-2 of Act 5 of Chapter 720 of the Illinois Compiled Statute defines, for the purpose of section 11-20.1, the following terms:
 - (a) "Computer" means a device that accepts, processes, stores, retrieves or outputs data, and includes but is not limited to auxiliary storage and telecommunications devices connected to computers.
 - (b) "Computer program" or "program" means a series of coded instructions or statements in a form acceptable to a computer which causes the computer to process data and supply the results of the data processing.
 - (c) "Data" means a representation of information, knowledge, facts, concepts or instructions, including program documentation, which is prepared in a formalized manner and is stored or processed in or transmitted by a computer. Data shall be considered property and may be in any form including but not limited to printouts, magnetic or optical storage media, punch cards or data stored internally in the memory of the computer
 - (d) "property" means:
 - 1.) electronic impulses
 - 2.) electronically produced data
 - 3.) confidential, copyrighted or proprietary information
 - 4.) private identification codes or numbers which permit access to a computer by authorized computer users or generate billings to consumers for purchase of goods and services, including by not limited to credit card transactions and telecommunications services or permit electronic fund transfers;
 - 5.) software or programs in either machine or human readable form;
 - 6.) any other tangible or intangible item relating to a computer or any part thereof.



- (e) "Access" means to use, instruct, communicate with, store data in, retrieve or intercept data from, or otherwise utilize any services of a computer.
- (f) "Services" includes but is not limited to computer time, data manipulation or storage functions.
- (g) "Vital services or operations" means those services or operations required to provide, operate, maintain, and repair network cabling, transmission, distribution, or computer facilities necessary to ensure or protect the public health, safety, or welfare. Public health, safety, or welfare include, but are not limited to, services provided by medical personnel or institutions, fire departments, emergency services agencies, national defense contractors, armed forces or militia personnel, private and public utility companies, or law enforcement agencies.
- 15.) For purposes of this affidavit, unless otherwise specifically indicated, the term "computer" refers to the box that houses the central processing unit (CPU), along with any internal storage devices (such as internal hard drives) and internal communications devices (such as internal modems capable of sending/receiving electronic mail or FAX cards) along with any other hardware stored or housed internally. Thus, "computer" refers to hardware, software and data contained in the main unit. Printers, external modems (attached by cable to the main unit), monitors, and other external attachments will be referred to collectively as peripherals and discussed individually when appropriate. When the computer and all peripherals are referred to as one package, the term "computer system" is used. Information refers to all the information on a computer system including both software applications and data.



- 16.) The term "c uter hardware" as used in his affidavit refers to all equipment which can collect, analyze, create, display, convert, store, conceal, or transmit electronic, magnetic, optical, or similar computer Hardware includes (but is not limited to) any dataimpulses or data. processing devices (such as cental processing units, memory typewriters, and self-contained "laptop" or "notebook" computers); internal and peripheral storage devices; peripheral input/output devices, transistor-like binary devices, and other memory storage devices; peripheral input/output devices (such as keyboards, printers, scanners, plotters, video display monitors, and optical readers); and related communications devices (such as modems, cables and connections, recording equipment, RAM or ROM units, acoustic couplers, telephone dialing automatic dialers, speed dialers, programmable or signaling devices, and electronic tone generating devices); as well as any devices, mechanisms, that can be used to restrict access to computer hardware (such as physical keys and locks).
- 17.) The term "computer software" as used in this affidavit refers to digital information which can be interpreted by a computer and any of its related components to direct the way they work. Software is stored in electronic, magnetic, optical, or other digital form. It commonly includes programs to run operating or parts (such as systems, applications spreadsheet programs), communications programs. Your affiant is aware that computer hardware and computer software may be utilized to store records which include, but are not limited to, those relating to business activities, criminal activities, associate names and addresses, and the identity and location of assets illegally gained through criminal activity.
- 18.) The term "computer-related documentation" used in this affidavit refers to written, recorded, printed, or electronically stored material which explains or illustrates how to configure or use computer hardware, software, or other related items.



- 19.) Computer par ords and other data securi devices are designed to restrict access to or hide computer software, documentation or data. Data security devices may consist of hardware, software, or other programming code. A password is a string of alpha-numeric, or other special characters operates as a "digital key" to "unlock" particular data devices. Data security hardware may include encryption devices chips, and circuit boards. Data security software or digital code may include programming code that creates "test" keys or "hot" keys, which perform certain pre-set security functions when touched. Data security software or code may also encrypt, compress, hide, or "booby-trap" protected data to make it inaccessible or unusable, as well as reverse the process to restore it.
- 20.) The terms "record(s)", "document(s)", and "material(s)" include all information recorded in any form, visual or aural, including but not limited to the following:
 - a.) Written or printed matter of any kind, correspondence, records, telegrams, contracts, reports, checks, statements, receipts, returns, summaries, pamphlets, books, ledgers, journals, registers, records, vouchers, slips, bills, calendars, pads, notebooks, files, logs, lists, bulletins, credit materials, data bases, teletypes, telefaxes, invoices, worksheets;
 - b.) Graphic records or representations, photographs, slides, drawings, designs, graphs, charts, pictures, sketches, images, films, videotapes, and aural records or representatives, tapes, records, and disks; the originals and all non-identical copies thereof.
 - c.) All of the foregoing, as set forth in subparagraphs a and b, in whatever form and by whatever means created or stored, including but not limited to any handmade form, any photographic form (such as microfilm, microfiche, prints, slides, negatives, videotapes, motion pictures, photocopies), any mechanical form(such as phonograph records, printing, or typing), any electrical, electronic or magnetic form (such as tape recordings or magnetic disks, printer buffers, smart cards, memory calculators, electronic dialers, Bernoulli drives, or electronic notebooks, as well as printouts or readouts from any magnetic store device).
- 21.) Based upon your affiant's knowledge, training and experience, your affiant knows that the INTERNET is a world wide computer network which connects computers and allows communications and the transfer of data and

information across sta and national boundaries. Individuals that utilize the INTERNET can communicate by using electronic mail (hereinafter referred to as "E-mail"). E-mail is an electronic form of communication which can contain letter type correspondence and graphic images. E-mail is similar to conventional paper type mail in that it is addressed from one individual to another and is usually private. E-mail usually contains a message header which gives information about individual that originated a particular or graphic, and importantly, the return address to respond to them. E-mail may also contain "computer graphic files," as discussed below, which may be appended to a particular item of E-mail and thereby transmitted via the INTERNET.

- 22.) The visual depictions referred to in this affidavit are in the form of "computer graphic files," which are photographs that have been digitalized into computer binary format. Once in this format the graphic file can be viewed, copied, transmitted, and/or printed. Computer graphic files are differentiated by the type of format convention by which they were created. Two common types of computer graphic files encountered are those in JPEG (Joint Photographic Electronics Group) format having the "jpg" file extension, and the GIF (Graphic Interchange Format) format having the "gif" file extension. There are also other formats.
- 23.) Your affiant is aware that individuals who have access to the INTERNET have a subscription to, membership in, or affiliation with, an organization or commercial service which provides access to the INTERNET computer network. A provider of INTERNET access is referred to as an INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDER or ISP.
- 24.) ISPs allow their subscribers to communicate with other subscribers and with subscribers of other ISPs via E-mail. Using this system, ISP subscribers can send E-mail with computer text or graphic image files attached. For a certain period of time, ISPs maintain these



subscriber E-mails in ctronic storage on the I: computer servers.

- 25.) Pursuant to my training and experience, I have learned that:
 - a.) Child pornography is not readily available in retail establishments; accordingly, individuals who wish to obtain child pornography do so by ordering it from abroad or by discreet contact with other individuals who have it available.
 - b.) The use of computers to traffic in, trade, or collect child pornography and obscenity has become one of the preferred methods of obtaining obscene and child pornographic materials. An individual familiar with a computer can use it, usually in the privacy of his own home or office, to interact with another individual or a business offering such materials in this country or elsewhere in the world. The use of a computer provides individuals interested in obscenity or child pornography with a sense of privacy and secrecy not attainable by other media. It also permits the individuals to contact and interact with many more individuals than through the use of the mails.







THE COURT: We're here on case 99 CF 917, People versus William C Beck. Mr. Beck is in court in person with his attorney, Walter Braud. State is present by Assistant State's Attorney Jessie Guzman.

I called this case up for status this morning based on the fact that the State and defense have told me they were close to some type of plea agreement in this case. Is that correct, Miss Guzman?

MS. GUZMAN: Yes, it is, Your Honor.

THE COURT: Before accepting the pleas, Miss Guzman, would you give the court factual basis on each count?

MS. GUZMAN: I will, Your Honor. As to Count 1, sometime within the month of August approximately 21st of 1999, the minor, initials JDP, date of birth 10/13/82, was at the defendant's residence. The defendant made a habit of having younger juveniles at his home where they were allowed to drink alcohol and smoke and play video games and do things at his house.

THE COURT: This was going on at this time?

MS. GUZMAN: Yes, it was. It was ongoing. To what the kids would do would be frequent his house, and evidently the policy was that if you drank you had to stay at the residence overnight.

At some period of time this particular minor spent the night at the defendant's residence and evidently he was sleeping on the couch in the living room. At approximately 3:00 in the morning he was awakened by the defendant when he felt the defendant's hands on his genitals. The minor advised his pants were unzipped and partially down. He was wearing a T shirt, underwear at the time, and he advised that the defendant was rubbing his hand on his penis. He advised that this lasted about 20 seconds. The juvenile asked the defendant what he was



doing. At that time the defendant then seized doing that, told the minor that this would never happen again, and also asked the minor not to tell anyone. He got up and went to the basement where there were other people sleeping. At that time then the defendant would have been, his birth date was in '58. This occurred in 1999, so he would have been approximately 41 years old and--.

THE COURT: Minor would have been?

MS. GUZMAN: The minor would have been at the time 16 years old.

THE COURT: He was at least 13 but under 17 years of age.

MS. GUZMAN: Correct. As to Count 2, this is again another minor with the initials BNJ, date of birth is 9/14/82. BNJ is a member or was a member of the Moline High School golf team where the defendant was a coach. In approximately October of 1999 the minor had spent the night at the defendant's residence. Again I believe there was alcohol involved in that instance as well.

The minor stated that the defendant as he was asleep he awoke, he was awakened when he felt a hand on his lower stomach and upper crotch area. The juvenile advised that it was the defendant and his hand was down his pants, and when he woke up he realized that his pants were

unbuttoned and unzipped, and he said it was dark but he was aware it was the defendant because he recognized his voice because the defendant said to him just relax, let me do it. The minor advised that he hit the defendant's hand away and told him to get off of him. He then the minor fell back asleep, woke up later and left the residence.

THE COURT: This occurred at night? Is this when this occurred?

MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

THE COURT: And the minor was at the residence of the defendant?

MS. GUZMAN: Yes.

THE COURT: Was this a part of the ongoing party?

MS. GUZMAN: What happened in this one case this minor, I believe his parents were out of town and he did not, he was not allowed to stay at a friend's house, so what the parents wanted him to do was to stay with somebody they could trust and who they entrusted with this child's safety and they knew he would look out for him. He stayed. I believe the parents spoke to the defendant and then inquired as to if that was something that they could do and he agreed and. . .

THE COURT: He was the golf coach?

MS. GUZMAN: Exactly.

MR. BRAUD: I'm not sure if he was a golf coach at that time. He at some point was the golf coach.

MS. GUZMAN: That was why he was there actually, but the minor did inform us that he had been out drinking and that this was a place that he could stay when that happened. He did not actually make it to his genitals, but he was attempting to fondle his genitals for the purpose of sexual gratification of the defendant. At that time the minor would have been 16 years old.

THE COURT: He would have been 17 according to the date of birth, 9/14/82. The date is 29 of October, 1999.

MS. GUZMAN: I'm sorry. As to Count That's correct. 6, within the summer of 1998 the minor, whose initials are AJT, date of birth 7/8 of 83. During the course of the investigation we interviewed a lot of children. This minor came forward and informed the investigators that he first met the defendant as his Sixth grade teacher. began going over to the defendant's residence as part of the whole hang out place where they would swim in the pool, watch TV.

The minor indicated that he had spent the night at the defendant's residence. Again, that he said they would be drinking alcohol and that was the rule they had to stay there at the residence. The minor indicated that he

was in the kitchen getting pop, that the defendant began rubbing his shoulders and from behind tried putting his hands on his belly at the belt towards his waistline and he stopped him only after the defendant was rubbing and stroking the outside of the minor's pants and his crotch area outside of his clothes. At that time the defendant. . .

MS. GUZMAN: It was. From the conversations that we've had from the parents and the defendant is, was a teacher himself. They all were very much blinded by the defendant and his demeanor. Everybody thought he was a nice guy and he was a teacher. They were not aware that— They thought the kids were going over there to hang out. He had a swimming pool. He had a pool table, that they were hanging out over there, and it was a safe place to be as opposed to being on the street.

It turns out he was buying the kids alcohol and providing a place for them to drink. He would—— a couple of the kids had access to his house without him being there, and there have been occasions when there were kids there without his being there, and so I mean they knew insofar as they knew they were hanging out there.

THE COURT: Okay, Mr. Braud, do you agree with the statement of the facts as substantially correct what the State would present in a hearing at trial?

MR. BRAUD: With respect to the touching I think it's

all substantially correct. With regard to the circumstances surrounding the touchings, many of those would be disputed.

THE COURT: You think there's sufficient evidence here to prove the elements of the crime?



Defendant having been convicted of the offenses of Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse (Count II & VI) and Aggravated Criminal Sexual Abuse (Count II) in violation of 720 ILCS 5/12-16(d) (I & VI) and 720 ILCS 5/8-4(a) (II), pursuant to the provisions of 730 ILCS 5/5-5-3(g) is hereby ORDERED to present himself to Dr. Larry Peterson at the Rock Island County Correctional Center, located at 1317 - 3rd Avenue, Rock Island, Illinois, within ten (10) days of entry of this order and at that time and location submit to medical testing to determine whether the defendant has any sexually transmissible disease including infection with hum immunodeficiency virus (HIV) or any other identified causative agent of acquired immunodeficiency syndrome (AIDS).

The medical testing shall be performed only by an appropriately licensed medical practitioner(s) and may include an analysis of any of the defendant's bodily fluid as well as an examination of the defendant's person. Except as otherwise provided herein, the results of this test shall be kept strictly confidential by all medical personnel involved in the testing of the defendant.

An authorized person from the Rock Island County Health Department shall communicate the test results directly to the undersigned in writing and deliver same in a sealed envelope to the undersigned for in camera inspection.

The Court designates the Rock Island County Health Department, Director and designated employees thereof as liaison with and to are on

behalf of this court to do any/all of the following:

- Shall notify the defendant of the test results by the most practical and efficient means.
- Shall, upon confirmation of written request notify all persons who have been identified as a "victim" that a test has been performed upon the defendant and that the victim may obtain the results of that test in person at an appointed time or otherwise if requested from a staff member of the Rock Island County Health Department. Any victim under age 15 at time of commission of offense shall also have a parent or legal guardian notified and that parent or legal guardian shall accompany the victim during the revelation of defendant's test results to the victim(s).
- The Rock Island County Health Department shall provide information on the availability of HIV testing and counseling at Department of Public Health Facilities to all parties and shall, where deemed appropriate, provide such counseling to any party to whom test results are revealed.
- In the event that any person designated as a "victim" resides outside of the area where personal contact by Rock Island County Health Department to reveal test results cannot be accomplished, then Rock Island County Health Department, maintaining the same degree of confidentiality as previously described herein shall designate a Public Health Department or facility and designated employee/representative therein to notify in person, if practical the victim revealing the defendant's test result to victim within the County/State wherein the victim resides. ONLY AS A LAST RESORT SHALL THE DEFENDANT'S TEST RESULTS BE MAILED TO A VICTIM. method of notification should be specifically requested by the victim before it is to be utilized.

JUDGMENT - SENTENCE TO ILLINOIS DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS

WHEREAS the above-named defendant William C. Beck, DOB:5-27-58 as been adjudged guilty of the offenses enumerated below,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the defendant be and hereby is sentenced to confinement in the Illinois Department of Corrections for the term of years and months specified for each offense.

The Court finds that the defendant is entitled to receive credit for time actually served in custody of Rock Island County Sheriff's

Department from November 8, 1999 through November 10, 1999 and from December 27, 1999 through December 30, 1999 and from May 23, 2000 todate of delivery to the Illinois Department of Corrections.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant is ordered to pay the costs of prosecution herein. These fees, costs, and restitution (if applicable) are reduced to judgment against the defendant and are declared a lien upon the defendant's property. The defendant is ordered to see the payment hearing officer of Rock Island County within 28 DAYS of his release from the Department of Corrections to come up with a schedule for payment or schedule a court appearance to schedule payment.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court deliver a copy of this order to the Sheriff.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff take the defendant into custody and deliver him to the Department of Corrections which shall confine said defendant until expiration of his sentence or until he is otherwise released by operation of law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to Illinois Compiled Statutes, 730 ILCS 5/5-5-3(g), the defendant shall undergo medical testing to determine whether the defendant has any sexually transmissible disease, including a test for H.I.V. and A.I.D.S. The testing shall be performed only by appropriately licensed medical practitioners and may include an analysis of any bodily fluids as well as an examination of the defendant's person. Except as otherwise provided by law, the results of such testing shall be kept strictly confidential by all medical personnel and personally delivered in a sealed envelop to the judge of the court in which the conviction was entered for the judge's inspection in camera. The judge, acting in the best interests of the victim and the public, shall have discretion to determine to whom, if anyone, the results of the testing may be revealed. The cost of the testing shall be paid by the defendant and assessed as a cost of the proceeding, to be paid out of bond posted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant shall register as a sex offender pursuant to 730 ILCS 150/3. He shall read and sign all registration forms required by the Illinois State Police.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the defendant have specimens of his blood collected within forty-five (45) days at a place and time designated by the Illinois State Police for genetic marker analysis pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-4-3(b). The defendant shall pay an analysis fee of \$500.00.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Count I, II and VI are to run concurrently with one another.
